ELIGIBILITY

The candidate should possess either of the following:

- MS/DNB/DLO degree in ENT

EDUCATIONAL OBJECTIVES

The goals of the fellowship are to provide comprehensive, multidisciplinary training to individuals who are committed to a career in Otology practice.

The fellowship training will provide a broad exposure to the full range of clinical problems encountered in a tertiary otology practice.

Upon completion of fellowship, the candidate will possess the following characteristics:

- a) Expertise in the multidisciplinary management of patients with otology problems
- b) Knowledge and/or skills in microscopic ear surgeries
- c) Broad-based knowledge and comprehension of principles of audiological procedures

FELLOWSHIP CURRICULUM

FELLOWSHIP SCHEDULE

The candidate would spend at least 3 months in MESIARC, as resident in the speciality

FEE STRUCTURE & STIPEND

The course fee is Rs. 50,000/- and Rs. 10,000/- as the refundable caution deposit for 6 months course and Rs 30000/- for 3 months course. For sponsored candidates and candidates from other countries the institution may decide on the fee structure as appropriate.

There wont be any stipend paid for the fellow, as this program is purely academically oriented

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

The candidates will be full time residents of the institution and will perform the duties and responsibilities of a full time resident in ENT

TRAINING

The learning process will be facilitated by

- Clinical expertise gained by working alongside experienced Otologist
- Teaching sessions, which would include inter disciplinary seminars (involving audiology)
Journal clubs, and case presentation.
- Observing and Assisting procedures

EVALUATION

This will be done on a continual basis with respect to the overall objectives of the course, and specifically with respect to their skills

Final examination
